Dear CMAC Member

Your 2009-10 membership of CMAC and your associated MAAA insurance coverage will terminate on 30 June 2010. To make sure of continued insurance coverage, you should renew your membership prior to that date.

To do so, please follow this procedure:

1. read the attached CMAC Membership Fees 2010-11 form and determine the renewal fee amount you will need to pay (\$200, \$80 or \$30 for full members)
2. write a cheque/postal order¹ for the appropriate membership subscription fee amount, payable to "CMAC" or make an Electronic Funds Transfer²
3. fill in the attached CMAC Membership Application 2010-11 form, highlighting the RENEW option, and please include your date-of-birth which is now required for MAAA insurance renewals
4. either post the completed form and payment to Membership Registrar, CMAC, PO Box 387, Woden, ACT 2606
or
hand them to David Haycraft or another CMAC committee member.

Once a valid membership form and subscript fee have been received we will send you promptly an official CMAC receipt, using e-mail where possible. MAAA insurance commences from the date on the CMAC receipt.

We will then forward your details to the MAAA who will periodically print batches of new MAAA Membership Card for 2010-11 and return them to CMAC for distribution to members. It may take several weeks before you get your new MAAA Card. If you need one quickly for competition purposes, please ask me to expedite its issue.
