

CMAC Safety & Field Induction Checklist



Field Layout

- Proximity to sensitive facilities
- Member & visitors parking area
- Pits area / tables - setup only, arming / starting in pits area not permitted
- Taxiways and engine kill lines
- Pilot's box
- Control line area / Heli-Drone pad

Amenities

- Clubhouse (kitchen, inverter, water, tea and coffee, toilet, urinal)
- Storeroom: chairs, pack up after use)
- Clean-up after yourself (take bulky rubbish home with you including crashed aircraft)

Safety

- Read and understand club procedures
- Code of Conduct – be respectful
- First Aid Kit location, First Aid Register
- No fly area – east of runway centreline
- Fire Equip/Crash buckets – location, contents, use
- Emergency procedures – Notice Board
- Incident Reporting procedures / forms
- Radios / frequency management
- Heavy models >7kg must be inspected by appropriately qualified MAAA inspector
- Pilot's box – keep out unless directly assisting, no mobile use
- 'Fly Safely' – do not fly over or near people or vehicles using surrounding nature reserve.

Security

- Access code – members only
- Opening / Closing procedures
- Field Gate and Clubhouse Locks - must not be left open, lock and scramble, set alarm
- Check if you are 2nd or 3rd last person to leave that the members remaining know how to lock-up

Flight Procedures

- Pre-flight checks, control surfaces, range checks, fail safe
- Start-up tables / poles – keep clear for others when not flying, clean-up fuel spills
- Check your model & flight compatible with any already flying - maybe seek a dedicated session
- Maiden Flights – consider seeking help
- Aerobatic / unusual models
- Pilot announcements and meaning – take-off, landing, touch and go, low level pass, on strip, clear, heads up, dead stick.
- Acknowledge all announcements
- Field ceiling height – 400 feet. Reduce height or land if general aviation aircraft approach field.

Training (new students only)

- CMAC Flight Training – instructor /club trainers
- Flight Simulators – benefits
- Wings System – Bronze, Silver, Gold
- Seek instructor advice before purchasing first radio, plane, flight simulator.

Visitors

- Must be MAAA / FAI member to fly
- Must produce a current MAAA card
- Complete Visitors Book @ each visit
- Max four visits per membership year
- Must be hosted by a CMAC member

Other

- Not permitted at the field:
 - Any pets / dogs, including in a car
 - Free Flight models
 - Fully autonomous models
 - Flying in fog/smoke
 - Consumption of alcohol before flying
- Total Fire Bans – field closed no flying
